I have been a priest for over 50 years here in the Diocese of Owensboro, Ky (western Kentucky); however, I am from the coal regions of northeastern Pennsylvania. I come from a family of coal (anthracite) miners - even my mother worked in the office of the coal mine. My mother died when I was young and my sister and I were raised by my father and grand-parents until my father remarried. However, his second wife was my mother for 55 years. I have a full sister, a stepsister and a half-brother, but we just refer to each other as our brother and sister since these are the only parents we have known.

For most of my priesthood I have been a teacher, mostly at Brescia University where I taught Old Testament. My dearest friend was Fr. Joe O'Donnel, who was the Catholic Bishops' representative in the Roman Catholic -Southern Baptist dialogue. And that makes me very happy to be with you today.
